### **Stewardship Special Giving for January: Mountaineers' Table**

The Ephrata **Mountaineer's Table** is enrolling new families for the school year. The **Mountaineer's Table** is designed to help families stretch their grocery money, prepare low-cost meals for their families over the weekend, and have their children well-fed and ready to learn.

Every Thursday, participating families receive a recipe and the ingredients to make the meal. Additional items including cereal, peanut butter, soups, and fresh fruits and vegetables are distributed. Helpful information is also included in the weekly packs, including "Smart Shopping Tips," "Clever Ways to Use Leftovers," and "Food to Always Have On Hand." There is no cost to participate, but there are expectations: **Program participants will be expected to pick up their food every Thursday evening at the Ephrata Church of the Brethren located at 201 Crescent Avenue in Ephrata. Failure to do so will result in being removed from the program.**

### **Treasurer's Report January, 2026**

Thank you for the generous contributions and financial support in 2025. As you can see, we ended 2025 with a Unified Budget **Balance** of \$9,030.85. That balance will be transferred to our unrestricted reserve funds.

**Elevator Fund Contributions:** \$4,000.00 was contributed for elevator renovation in December. Also in December, we made a second payment to Otis Elevator for the equipment to be installed of \$47,118.75. The two payments made to date total \$136,868.75. To make these payments, we have withdrawn \$114,705.00 from our unrestricted reserve funds. The remainder of the payments are from contributions to the elevator fund.

## Treasurer

### Holy Trinity is seeking someone to serve as treasurer beginning in 2027.

Larry Hummer completed two 3-year terms as treasurer in December 2025, the maximum allowed by our constitution. The Congregation Council decided to suspend the treasurer term limit and elected Larry to serve as treasurer until the end of 2026. This decision gives the Finance Committee and Council time to decide how to redefine the position.

We are searching now so that the new treasurer can be tutored by our present treasurer later this year. More importantly, we want the person to be part of the discussion with the Finance Committee as we decide how to handle the position and congregational finances going forward.

## Congregation Council Report

At the January 8 Congregation Council meeting:

- The Council re-affirmed that the Property Committee will manage the use (rental) of the building and parking lot. The Property Committee will have tenants (groups or individuals using our facilities) complete appropriate forms, provide contact information, and, where needed, provide proof of insurance.
- The Council approved the yoga class request to switch from using the building Monday evenings to Monday mornings.

Donations may be dropped off directly at Bergstrasse when the Community Clothing Closet is open or in the box at the back of the narthex in Holy Trinity.

**Volunteers:** sort clothing, hang it and tag it by color to keep track of what is moving and what is not, and greet shoppers at the courtesy desk. Shoppers check in and specify how many people they are shopping for and what items are of particular interest. Volunteers are needed from 11:30 – 2:30 on Saturdays and

Sundays. You do not need to be there the entire time to volunteer – whatever time you have available within those timeframes is fine.
